

## Background Information

Whilst women around the world are slowly getting better represented in top level leadership positions in political and social spheres, they still face many barriers such as discrimination, gender stereotyping, balancing work/family commitments and prejudice. These barriers help maintain the gender gap and prevent women from fulfilling their potential and contributing to national and global social, political and economic development goals.

The recognition of the important relationship between women's leadership and decision-making roles and women's empowerment, global development, prosperity and peace has pushed this issue higher up on the global development agenda. Examples of the issue's importance can be seen in Goal 5 of the new United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), which is devoted to women's empowerment and the introduction of UN led initiatives such as the first ever high level UN panel on women and the economy which aims to intensify global efforts to reduce the gender gap in all spheres of social and political life. This lecture and panel session will cover several of these issues, providing a timely follow-up to the global commitments made in the Beijing Platform for Action and the subsequent Beijing +20 discussion outcomes as well as the SDG goals for women's empowerment.
